

STUDENT ENROLLMENT

I. POLICY STATEMENT:

A child must be three years of age on or before September 1st to be eligible for Pre-K services; five years of age on or before September 1st to be eligible for enrollment in kindergarten; and six years of age on or before September first to be eligible for enrollment in first grade.

1. Proof of the child's age must be furnished by parent or guardian upon enrolling the child in school for the first time. A certificate of birth must be presented.
2. As required by law, a copy of the child's complete immunization record must be presented.
3. Any student transferring from another district shall be placed in the same grade as he/she was in at the previous school, regardless of birth date.
4. Children turning three after September 1 may be eligible for enrollment in Pre-K based on a decision of an IEP team.

This policy is consistent with 16 V.S.A. ss. 1073 et seq.
